The Linden Woods Community Foundation is pleased to announce the recipients of the 2021-22 scholarship, who each received \$1.100. With the additional challenges posed by the pandemic. it was gratifying to make the pursuit of post secondary stud-

ies a little bit easier for at least two students.

Doris Goubran (photo) has lived in Linden Woods since elementary school and is currently in her third year of Health Sciences (Interdisciplinary Health Program) at the University of Manitoba, expecting to graduate in May 2023. In addition to full time studies, she is an executive member of the Community Health Students Association and has been involved in several volunteer activities. These include Winnipeg Harvest, Sunday School, and instructing at science workshops for school children in Winnipeg and rural Mani-

Sydney Mead is in her second year studying biochemistry at the University of Winnipeg, expecting to graduate in spring 2023, after which she hopes to attend medical school at the University of Manitoba. Her goal is to become a family phy-

sician, practicing in and around Winnipeg. She has lived in Linden Woods since she was 7 years old, attending Van Walleghem School from grade 3 to 8.

The Linden Woods Community Foundation Scholarship is awarded annually to students attending the University of Manitoba and the University of Winnipeg. Applicants must have been a resident of Linden Woods for at least 2 of the last 5 years, enrolled full-time in second or subsequent year of studies, and have demonstrated community involvement and initiative. The endowment fund is managed by the Winnipeg Foundation.

The LWCF Board is grateful for the continuing donations to the scholarship fund, which allow the endowment fund and the annual scholarships to grow. Snow and Ice Troubles


