UPDATE on the KLEYSEN PARK matching donations

In case you missed it or a refresher is in order, a \$25,000 donation to the **Linden Woods Community Foundation** by **Hubert and Bernice Kleysen** kick-started an enhancement project that includes expansion of the play structure, sheltered picnic tables, more trees, bicycle racks, and
