A Community Centre is a public location in which neighbours can come together as a group to enjoy group activities, social support, public information and other purposes that will with enrich the lives of the neighbours within the community. There is no membership fee to join the Centre. They are generally open for the whole community and may have the ability to house music/dance activities, sport activities, social support activities, coffee mornings, games, fundraisers and other things to enjoy. Often there are hall or facility rentals available for family, club, or church events.

You can meet new people and make new friends, as well as learn new skills, new sports, etc. A Community Centre is normally located within easy walking distance or bus route for the community it serves.

No job too big or small, Community Service helps us all. Your community needs you. Will you answer the call?
