Three committees have been established by the Board to review the survey results, and to make recommendations for future actions and policy development:

Facility Planning Committee, chaired by **Grant Boak**, will determine and prioritize areas of maintenance and improvement at the LWCC that are immediate, mid-term, and long-term. As projects are identified, subcommittees may be established to oversee their further development. The first of these subcommittees has undertaken the task of improving our curb appeal with a new landscape design for the front of the building.

Program Committee, chaired by **Tracey Wright**, is reviewing current programming offered at the centre and will prepare a list of new programming options to offer to the community.

Communications Committee, chaired by **Julie Bubnick**, will develop policies and procedures that ensure consistency across all platforms (social media, web site, newsletter), in the areas of advertising, content, and archiving. The committee will also develop an implementation plan for ongoing community engagement.

The committees worked diligently over the summer, meeting several times, compiling, reviewing, and analyzing information. The aim is for each committee to prepare preliminary reports in early Fall. Stay tuned for more developments.

Linden Words – Changes are coming

In response to requests for more timely information in the newsletter and more frequent deliveries, beginning in January 2022 we will be reverting to eight issues a year. However, doubling the frequency also doubles the cost. At \$1,614 per issue for printing and postage, that works out to \$12,912 for a year. To offset that cost, we have put together an advertising package that will include regular spots in “Linden Words”, on the web site and social media accounts, and a rotating banner on the wall-mounted TV outside the general office and gym. The package costs \$800 or \$1,600 for the year, depending on the option selected. There is also an early-bird bonus for advertisers who sign up before November 6, 2021.

Linden Woods CC – Changes are coming



Thanks to the hard work of **Reza MirRashed**, Director of House & Grounds, and funding from the City of Winnipeg, two major renovation projects will be underway as soon as the requisite permissions and building permits are in place.

The first project, cost shared 50% by the Community Incentive Grant Program, will upgrade the lighting in the gym and the multipurpose room, add a ceiling light fixture in the multipurpose room, and install a window in the rear-facing wall (west) of the multipurpose room. The total cost of this project will be \$27,423.

The second project, funded 100% by the Community Centre Renovation Program, will upgrade all exterior lights, including rink and building exterior, at a cost of \$88,442. We will be upgrading the parking lot lights at the same time, at a cost of \$3,885 (funded by internal resources).

Front Line Classroom Supports

Across Manitoba, skilled and dedicated teachers, staff and school leaders support quality education and improve student outcomes each and every day. To assist teachers in their efforts, the Manitoba Government’s Department of Education has created the **Manitoba’s Teachers’ Idea Fund**. This is a five-year, **\$25 million investment** in the ideas and innovations of front-line teachers, staff and school leaders from across our province.

On July 16, 2021, **Brian Pallister, MLA for Fort Whyte** announced **Linden Meadows School** as one of the recipients for the 2021 Teachers’ Idea Fund. The school received \$25,000 for a digitized library for multilingual and multicultural books for K-8 students and families.

Manitoba educators brought forward diverse ideas over five required themes (see link for more information). Linden Meadows proposed project focussed on meeting a need within the local school community and demonstrated creativity in their approach to supporting student success.
